Re: Outcome of application for initial CRICOS registration—granted

I refer to your application to register under the *Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000* (the ESOS Act).

In accordance with the provisions of Sections 9AB and 170 (2) of the ESOS Act, the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) has determined that your application for registration on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students (CRICOS) is granted. A copy of the final CRICOS Audit Report is attached for your reference.

CRICOS has been updated to reflect the courses, locations and the maximum number of students at each location that your organisation is registered to provide.

Please note that under Section 8 of the ESOS Act it is an offence to provide or make an offer to an overseas student to provide a course at a location unless you are registered to provide that particular course at that particular location.

Maximum Number of Students

ASQA has considered the capacity of your organisation in terms of its premises, approved arrangements with other providers, facilities, resources, equipment, materials and the ratio of staff to student numbers.

The maximum number of overseas students approved by ASQA is 120 at your Dandenong premises and 100 at your Adelaide site.

The CRICOS Code

Your organisation has been allocated with a unique identifier on CRICOS (the CRICOS Code) and that will be advised to you as soon as possible. Please quote this CRICOS Code as well as your Registered Training Organisation (RTO) ID number in all future correspondence with ASQA.

Conditions on Registration

There are no conditions imposed on your organisation's registration.

Period of Registration

Your organisation has been granted registration for a period of five years which commenced on 6 March 2014 and is due to expire on 21 February 2019.

Your organisation can apply to ASQA to renew or withdraw its registration, and there are timeframes and obligations that apply to each process. There are also obligations on organisations that effectively cease to operate, even though they remain as registered providers. Changes to CRICOS Registration

Please note that an application to change your organisation's RTO VET Scope of Registration is **not** also an application to vary its CRICOS registration. An application to change your organisation's CRICOS registration must be submitted separately.

- Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000;
- Education Services for Overseas Students Regulations 2001; and
- National Code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2007.

Your organisation must also comply with the VET Quality Framework (as defined in the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011*).
