

Domestic Enrolment on Non-Student Visa Policy

1. Purpose

This policy sets out Job Training Institute's approach to enrolling individuals who do not hold a Student visa (subclass 500) but have lawful study rights under another Australian visa as domestic, self-funded (non-CRICOS) students.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all domestic, self-funded enrolments for students holding non-student visas with study rights, including Tourist and Bridging visas.

3. Policy Statement

Job Training Institute may enrol eligible non-Student visa holders as domestic, self-funded students provided no CoE is issued and no PRISMS reporting occurs.

4. Eligible Visa Types

- Tourist visa with study rights
- Bridging visa (including MRT/AAT) with study rights

5. Prohibited Activities

- Issuing a CoE
- Reporting in PRISMS
- Commencing CRICOS delivery

6. Visa Verification

Visa status must be verified prior to enrolment and recorded.

7. Student Declaration

Students must sign a declaration confirming non-CRICOS status.

8. Transition to Student Visa

A new enrolment and CoE may only occur after Student visa grant.

9. Compliance

This policy aligns with ESOS Act 2000, National Code 2018, and ASQA Standards.
